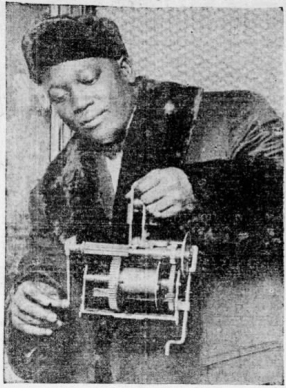
Champion Says He Will Manufacture Machine and Earn Enough Money to Retire.

## JELLISSON FAILS IN PINCH

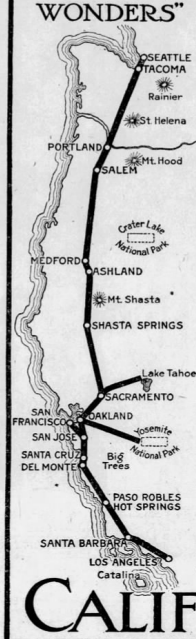
Only Able to Score Spare in Tenth Frame and Contest Is Lost by Narrow Margin.
